

# Where is the Love? — by Brady Horner

Last week a lot of people were up in arms about the addition of a "teen sex education book" to the Abilene Public Library. I did my research (saw the most shocking pages, read about the authors, and read reviews) and it's pretty shocking. It has lots of vulgar drawings and encourages pornography use, sexting, any form of sex with anyone, and one-night stands. Honestly, had middle school Brady seen this book, I would have checked it out for some good laughs with friends. At first, I thought it was just written for shock value, you know, to get small town West Texas people worked up (you may be surprised to hear that the authors are from Portland). But upon reading the reviews, there are actually people using this book to educate their kids! The whole ordeal brings up some interesting issues in our society.

In the reviews of the book, people kept using the term "sex-positive". The idea being that any form of consensual sexual activity is good, healthy, and should be encouraged. It seems to be an extreme pendulum swing from what some of us were taught. No one said "sex is bad" but perhaps subliminally we did. For many, the topic of sex is so taboo and awkward that it doesn't get discussed at all. Thus, kids are getting their sex education in unhealthy places, like peers, the internet, and weirdos in Portland with strange agendas. So, one lesson here is, you need to talk with your kids about sex, and unfortunately, probably earlier than you want to.

We need to let them know that sex is good or "positive", in its proper place. We need space to talk about taboo/intimate human issues like sex. The book leaves out any talk of love! Sex is a very intimate, sacred, connecting act that should not be engaged in with random people. I have a recently divorced friend who went and lived out what this book and much of our culture preaches about sex, "If it feels good do it". He said there is something very empty in sex without love...I wouldn't know. What this book preaches is actually very sad. It would have us chasing around the next hedonistic pleasure or "high", when what we are really all craving is deep human relationships filled with intimacy and love. I'm beginning to see a theme in the human experience: when something seems twisted, wrong, or unhealthy, it's usually because love is what is missing (see 1 Corinthians 13).
