Back to school

Children in Haiti will return to school on October 1, according to the Ministry of Education. Every year, sending kids to school is a nightmare for parents. It is not always possible for them to cover tuition fees, books, uniforms, and school supplies. Haiti's socioeconomic and political

situation has deteriorated in recent years, and the situation has worsened. Many children are uncertain about attending school this year because their parents might not be able to afford it. Even though it is impossible to help every child in need, we can support one at a time. Together we will make a positive impact on their lives.

Order my steps

Zanmi nou yo, it was still in the works that Brother Megeste would attend Lipscomb University this fall. Due to difficulties obtaining a visa, Brother Megeste and his wife, Josette, had a second interview with the U.S. Embassy on August 21. Once again, their visa application was denied. As of now, Brother Megeste's starting date for the program has been extended, but obtaining the visa remains a challenge. Since the DR officially closed its borders with Haiti in March, all flights between Haiti and the DR have been canceled. As far as we can tell, they are trapped in the DR without an easy way out. We would like to ask you to continue to pray for them, that doors of opportunity will be opened for them by the Lord. The emotional toll of being trapped in the DR has been immense for Brother Megeste and Josette. They have experienced feelings of isolation and helplessness, as the uncertainty of their situation looms over them. This prolonged state of limbo has tested their mental and emotional fortitude, leaving them yearning for stability and a clear path forward.

Your work is not in vain

CFC not only plants a seed of hope but also witnesses the growth of some of



them. Gismy Jean-Charles, a product of the ministry, is one of CFC's leaders on the rise. He is currently serving as a leader in the church's youth group. Both for the church and for Haiti, we are mentoring future leaders. We rejoice when we see some of those, who we support, joining hands with us to make a difference in Haiti. There seems to be no way out of the impasse, but we believe that God can and will raise the nation from the ashes. Like Gismy, many other volunteers are stepping forward to help. It is not in vain that you pray and donate. Thank you for your prayers and support.


